SUNBURNS: Use lots of sunscreen. You may try different brands with different ingredients. My personal favorite is the zinc oxide type. But, find what works best for your child. You may decide to use a spray on their body and cream on their face. Don't forget to apply sunscreen before arriving at the center and reapply during a day outdoors.

WATER SAFETY: You should reassess your child's swim abilities before every trip to water. Floatation equipment approved by the US Coastguard is best; your child's life is worth it. Active supervision is always important. Make it a habit to keep a child within arm's reach when playing in or around water.

HYDRATION: Dehydration happens quickly. In the heat, children sometimes have a hard time realizing they are thirsty. Remind them to drink water regularly. Electrolyte filled Gatorade popsicles or getting a personalized new water bottle can also help with keeping a child well-hydrated.
